Interesting Facts of Biology

Biology is the study of life and living organisms, from microscopic bacteria to massive dinosaurs. It is a fascinating subject that reveals many secrets and wonders of the natural world. Here are some interesting facts of biology that you may not know.



- * The human body produces enough saliva in a lifetime to fill up two swimming pools.
- * The human brain stops growing after the age of 18, and loses about 1000 brain cells every day.
- * The human heart can squirt blood up to 30 feet when it pumps blood through the body.
- * The human skin is the largest organ in the body, covering about 17-20 square feet and weighing about 20% of the total body weight.
- * The human lung can float on water because it is mostly filled with air.
- * The human skeleton has 300 bones at birth, but only 206 bones as an adult, because some bones fuse together as we grow.
- * Humans share about 50% of their DNA with bananas, and about 98% with chimpanzees.
- * Humans, koalas, and some primates have unique fingerprints that can be used to identify them.
- * The largest cell in the human body is the egg cell, which is about the size of a grain of sand. The smallest cell is the sperm cell, which is about 0.005 mm long.
- * The longest living animal is the immortal jellyfish, which can revert back to its immature stage and start its life cycle over again.
- * The fastest animal on land is the cheetah, which can run up to 120 km/h. The fastest animal in the air is the peregrine falcon, which can dive up to 320 km/h. The fastest animal in water is the sailfish, which can swim up to 110 km/h.
- * The loudest animal on Earth is the blue whale, which can produce sounds up to 188 decibels, louder than a jet engine. The quietest animal is the fairyfly, a tiny parasitic wasp that makes no sound at all.
- * The oldest living organism on Earth is a bristlecone pine tree in California, which is about 5067 years old. The oldest fossil ever found is a cyanobacterium that lived about 3.5 billion years ago.
- * The smallest living organism on Earth is a bacterium called *Mycoplasma genitalium*, which has only 525 genes and can only live inside other cells. The largest living organism on Earth is a fungus called *Armillaria ostoyae*, which covers about 9.6 square kilometers in Oregon.
- * The most venomous animal on Earth is the box jellyfish, which can kill a human in minutes with its powerful neurotoxins. The most poisonous animal on Earth is the golden poison frog, which has enough toxins in its skin to kill 10 humans.
