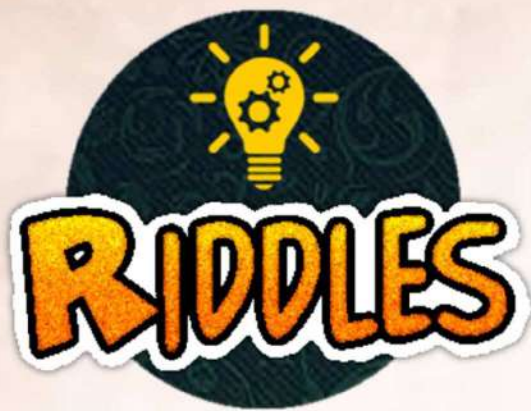

Ilama Fruit



- Ilama, is a fruit belonging to the Annonaceae family. The fruit is also known as Soncoya or Sincuya. The Ilama plants grow best in places where there is a long dry season followed by heavy rainfall. They grow in the tropical low lands of Mexico and Florida.
- The fruit is sweet and juicy with a distinct flavour. An average fruit is 15 cm long and weighs around 900 grams. They are cone – shaped, heart – shaped or ovular.
- They are available in green and pink. The green type has a flesh that is white and sweet, while the flesh of the pink is rose color and has a tart taste.
- Consumed just like any other fruit types, the flavor of the fruit is enjoyed with a different option. The fruit is best enjoyed when you follow this- Scoop out the inner flesh of the fruit and add some small quantity of cream and sugar and serve it chill. If you would like to intensify the flavor, you can add a dash of lemon to the fruit.
- Ilama trees are about 25 feet tall, often branching out at the ground level. The name is derived from the Spanish word Nahuatl *Ilamatzapotl* which means ‘old woman’s sapote’.

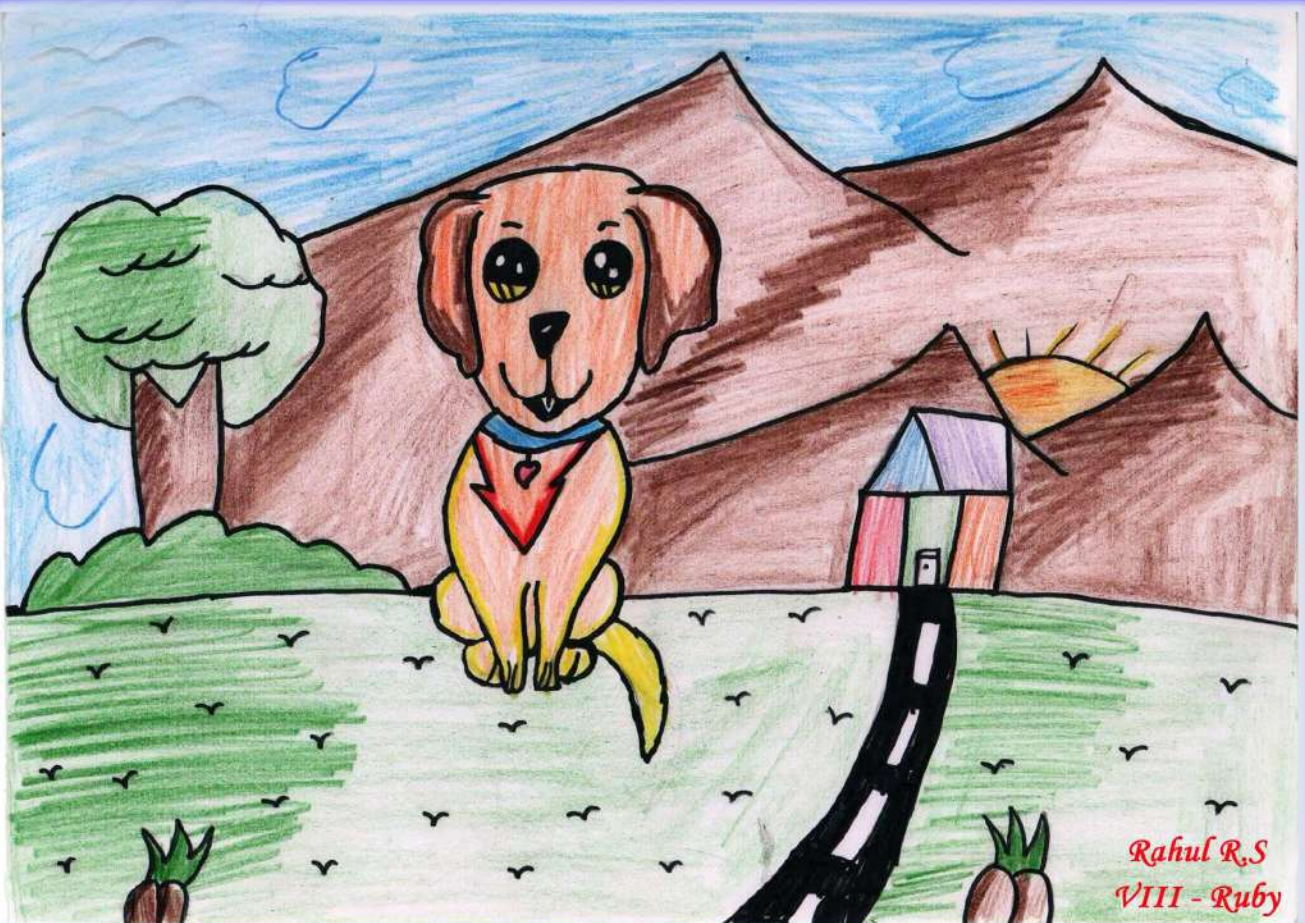

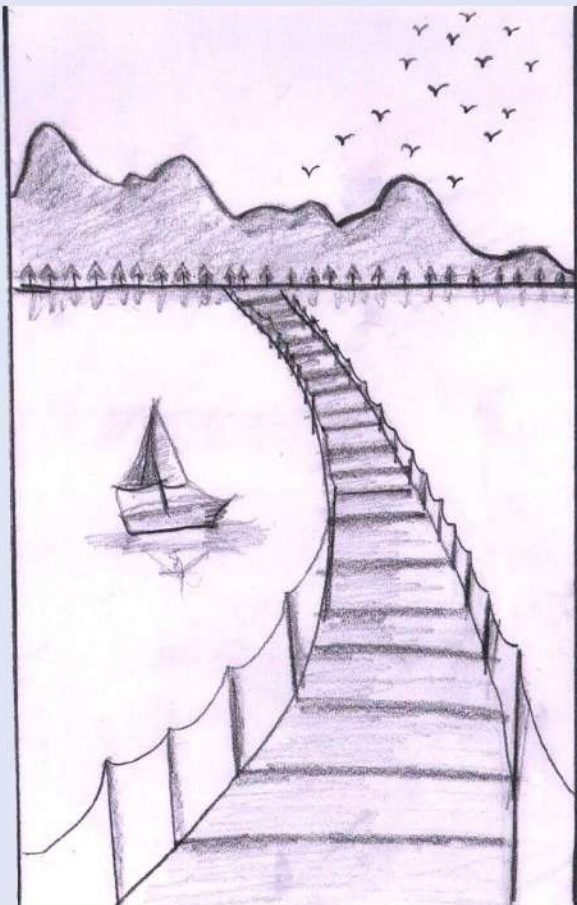

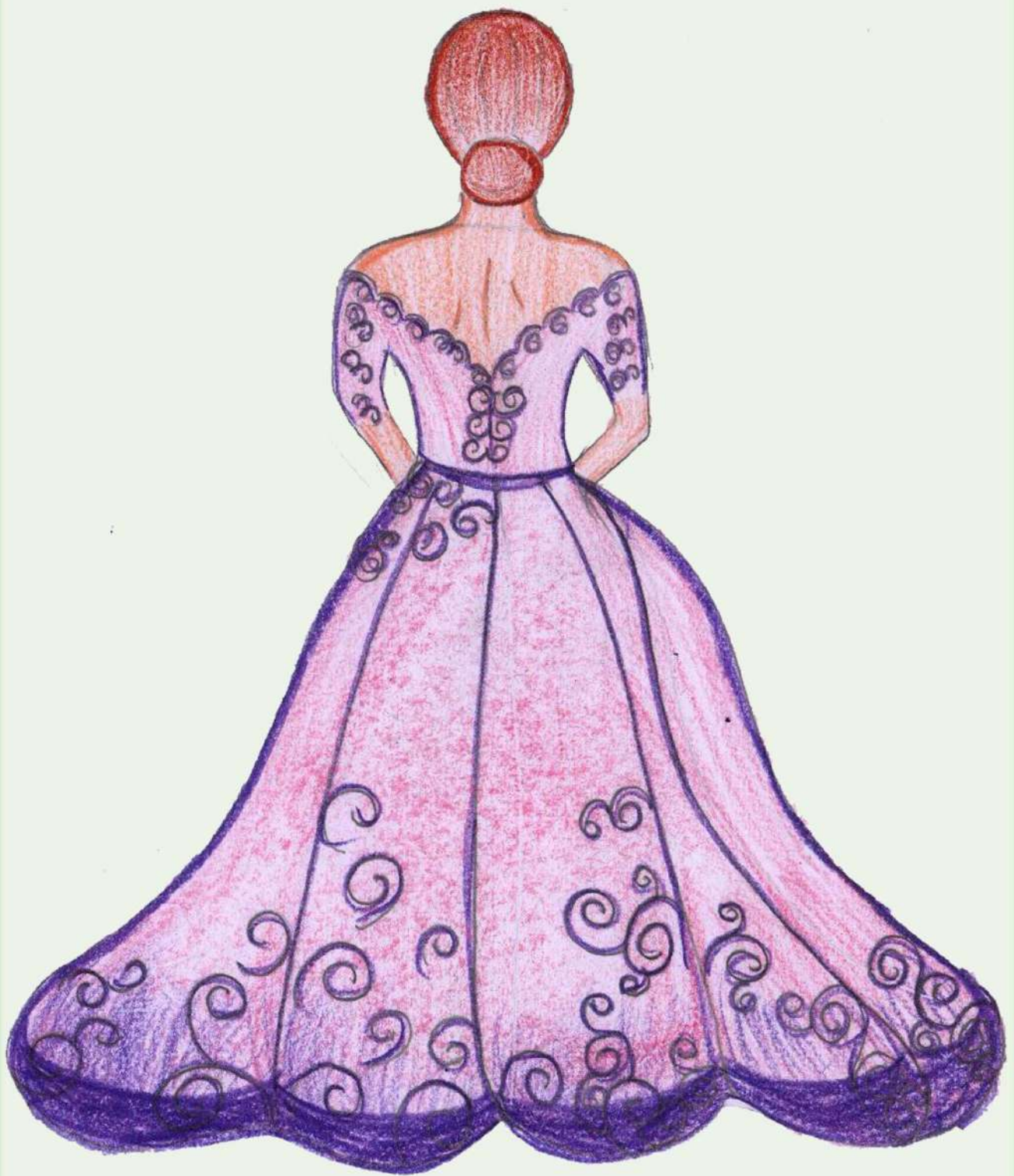

Be Safe

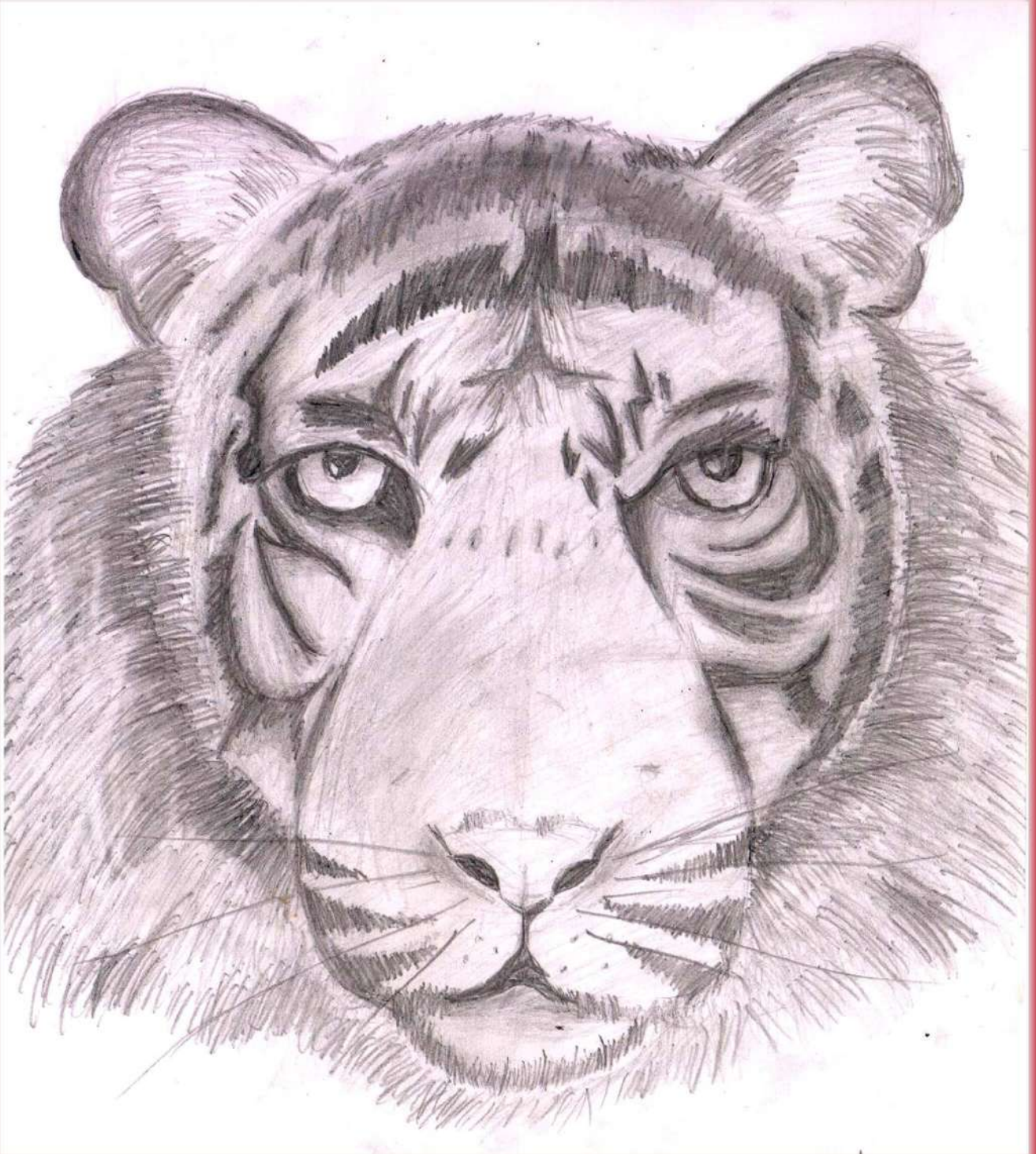
